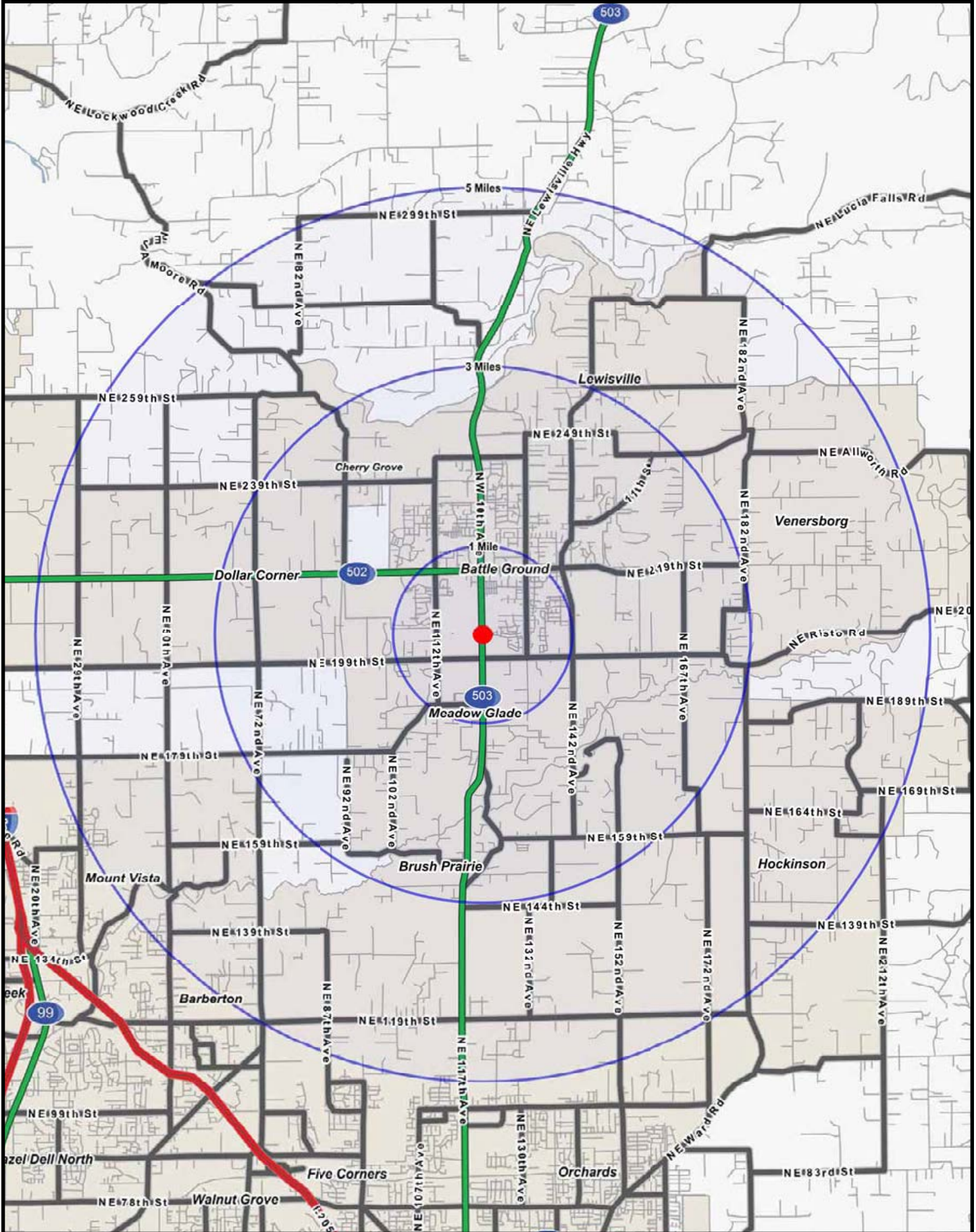


DEMOGRAPHIC MAP | BATTLE GROUND
